ADJUTANT NEWS

I hope everyone is staying cool and enjoying your summer. I wanted to remind you that Renewals are starting to come out. We have the 2025 Legion membership cards at the Post. Auxiliary and SAL will be coming soon. There is a slight increase in the Legion dues. I mentioned this before, but I wanted to mention it again. Dues have increased from \$45 a year to \$55 a year. It may seem like a lot, but it's only \$10. That's 2 cups of coffee from your favorite Java hut, a couple drinks at the bar, or 3 gallons of gasoline. The benefits you get can quickly make up the difference if you use your Legion membership for car rentals, some hotel rentals, health and welfare services and many others.
