### PICKLE MACHINES UPDATE

In recent weeks, five new pickle games have been added to our four pickle machines!

I. Our objective is to provide a variety of pickles with high payouts (for example 75% or more) and high tier level winnings, such as \$200 or more. We are planning to add more pickle games with high tier level winnings of \$500. In machine #2, West Coast Offense has been added. This \$.50 pickle's top tier winnings is \$250. Shake your Shamrocks pickle's top tier winnings is \$250 with 6 such pickles available for you to win for this \$1.00 pickle. This pickle has been added to machine #6 which already includes Wet Your Whistle, a \$1.00 pickle. The top tier winnings for Wet Your Whistle is \$500!! In machine #7, Cash Track and True Heroes (.25 pickles) have been added. Both have top tier winnings of \$100 or more.




