2021 was a bad year for the Honor guard. Dennis Guinane hit a patch of ice with his truck. It rolled down a hill three times landing on its top and he was upside down hanging by his seat belt. He is still seeing a doctor. Vince Mahoney & John Herrmann were riding their motorcycles in Colorado when a truck pulling a trailer tried to pass. The truck pulled back in the lane, hitting and killing Vince. John laid his bike down. He got his leg free from under the bike and tried to crawl to Vince but couldn't. John will be under a doctors' care for a long time. Brad Petersen was found dead of a heart attack in his home. Unfortunately, 2022 is picking up where 2021 left off. John Herrmann's wife Mary died of cancer. Mike Brookover, who was very active in the Legion, died of cancer.

In February 2010 my wife died. One night I said "Lord why did you take her from me?" He said "I didn't take her from you, I loaned her to you for 47 years. I wanted her home" We are here on loan - you never know when you will be called home. Are you prepared? Rod Mach, Chaplain
